1 Subjects

Know what subjects (core courses) the NCAA require you take, and have a 4 year academic plan to ensure you will be academically eligible.



3 SAT|ACT

Be aware of the testing the NCAA require you to complete, along with the score you need to be eligible. Be organised, and plan to take SAT in year 11, if required you can resit this.



2 Grades "GPA"

Be aware of what Grade Point Average (GPA) the NCAA require you to achieve. Work hard in your year 9 and 10 subjects as these grades count!



4 NCAA eligibility
