Policy Statement:

Basketball WA's (BWA) vision for the sport of Basketball is to be inclusive; regardless of sex, age, cultural and linguistic background and physical ability.

It is committed to promoting Basketball as 'a sport for everyone' through its inclusion programs and affiliated Associations. This provides Associations and Community groups the opportunity to support all members and encourages participants within the sport of Basketball.

Equity and Access Considerations:
