

# **COVID-19 BASKETBALL WA CONTROLS AND CHECKLIST:**



As at the 18th of May, basketball trainings are now permitted by Basketball WA under the following conditions. These strict controls meet the current restrictions of the WA Government.

## **STRICT CONTROLS – BASKETBALL TRAINING**

Outdoor and Indoor facilities allowed

Only one training group is allowed per functional space at any one time

Training groups should not cross over with each other

Benches should be removed from indoor training spaces

Non-Contact training drills only – No scrimmages

Maximum 20 participants (including coaches)

No equipment can be shared, other than a basketball, which must be sanitised before and after every training session

Change rooms should not be used and toilets should be used with appropriate hygiene and social distancing

Strictly one water bottle per participant (clearly labelled)

No hand-shaking or high fives permitted

Practice social distancing at all times of 1.5m (drills to be adjusted)

Coach responsible for risk assessment of court surface, ring & backboard at outdoor courts

Hand sanitiser to be used by all participants prior & post activities

No sharing of food/snacks (e.g. lollies or fruit)

Any participant feeling unwell must not attend or participate in activity

Spectators & parents to not attend if possible and to practice social distancing and avoid contact with the training group if they do

Participants in training should be encouraged to shower when they return home after training
