



HIGH-PERFORMANCE COACH APPOINTMENTS

OVERVIEW

Coaches that wish to be involved with one of the high-performance programs must be apply for a program position and be appointed by a Basketball WA high-performance representative before they are able to participate in that program.

This applies to all positions including:

- Head Coaches
- Assistant Coaches
- Development Coaches
- Campaign Coaches
- “Floor” (helper) coaches

SELECTION CRITERIA

For coaches to be eligible (**eligibility does not guarantee selection**) for a high-performance program staff position they must:

- Register an expression of interest to be a part of a High-performance program
- Be actively engaged in the BWA coaching pathway (FDP, SPP, WABL etc.)
- Have current recognised basketball coaching accreditation (community, club, or association level)
- Have a current and valid WWC card

Consideration for program selection will be based on:

- Previous relevant coaching or playing experience at NBL, NBL1, or college levels
- An understanding of the Basketball WA style of play
- Experience using technology to support the program and athletes
- Organisational and administrative skills including meeting deadlines and computer literacy
- Willingness to follow Basketball WA guidelines around selection, scheduling, and Style of play

COACH APPOINTMENT PROCESS

- For development programs (SCC HPDC etc.), coaches who have completed an application, will be selected for position's based on their coaching resume without going through an interview process.
- For State team's applications, coaches will be selected after being interviewed by a BWA High Performance panel. Applicants will only be offered an interview if they are in the top 3 shortlisted applicants, based on their basketball resume.

WHAT IS INCLUDED?

Coaches that are selected into a high-performance coaching position for the current cycle will be given the following resources:

- BWA HP Coach induction
- BWA HP coaching shirt
- Early access to any BWA coaching clinic footage or presentation's
- Access to coaching webinars from various professional's (coaches or other specialists)
- Access to Basketball WA coaching resources
- Invitation to attend a Perth Lynx training session
- Invitation to attend a Perth Wildcats training session

PERFORMANCE REVIEW

At the conclusion of the program, **Head coaches** will undertake a debrief and program review carried out by a member of the BWA high performance team.

Coaches may be offered an additional year in their current role without having to reapply based on their performance leading that program.
