### **JOB SUMMARY**

The Campaign Coach is responsible for supporting the state team program in line with the Basketball WA values and philosophies

**POSITION TITLE:** CAMPAIGN COACH  
**REPORTS TO:** Head Coach, assistant coach

### **SPECIFIC TASKS / KEY AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY**

- Be on court “Basket coaching” during trials and training sessions
- Be willing to lead drills if required by the head or assistant coach.
- Focus on and coach a specific area specified by the head coach (e.g., defensive transition, shot selection etc.)
- Able to add feedback to athlete evaluations/assessment
- Help with organising equipment or players. (e.g. putting athletes into teams for drills, hand out training bibs, make sure basketballs are pumped up etc.)
- Be open to learning and teaching BWA style of play concepts

- Community Coach Accreditation (formally level 0)
- Current Working with children card
