### Category of Nomination

Entities considering nominating a player, coach, referee or official to the Hall of Fame, should ensure their respective candidate meets the following criteria:

- Selection is based primarily upon on-field excellence, as opposed to long and loyal service to the game. Excellence and impact will be evidenced by regular representation at Local, State and National levels, individual awards, and/or outstanding success and achievement on the international stage or in professional basketball.
- In recognition of the importance of statistics to the history of basketball, statistical evidence of outstanding performance, applicable to playing and coaching records, must be provided as supporting evidence for Hall of Fame nomination.
- In the absence of available statistical evidence, potential inductees should be supported through written testimonials and/or oral histories (documented) from multiple sources.
- Nominees must have participated in a competition, league or team as a registered player of a Basketball WA Club, State Team, or Perth Wildcats or Lynx (or their predecessor) for a minimum period of 3 years (seasons).
- On-field personnel will only be considered for nomination if they have been retired from their on-field roles for 3 years. On-field personnel are considered "retired" if they have not played at State League (or above levels) for 3 or more years.
- Inductees must meet acceptable standards of integrity, character and sportsmanship, and must not have brought the sport of basketball into disrepute.
- The Commission reserves the right to crosscheck information provided in support of nominees at its discretion as part of the validation process.
