Procedures

FIBA have changed the scoretable procedures for a 4-person set up. If you have 5 officials, please proceed as usual with the Chair in place. If you do not have 5 then the Timer will be responsible for sounding the horn and calling substitutions, timeouts, changing the arrow and putting on the team foul lights. This is in addition to their other duties. The Scorer will continue to get the scoresheet checked, signed and starting 5 marked. Please make sure you establish with the Coaches the protocol for calling timeouts and emphasise that substitutions will only be called when the player presents.

Mobile Phones

Chairpersons/Timer, please make sure phones are away during the games in 2024. Once the warm-up has started no electronic devices (including watches) should be used by scorers until the game is complete. If they need to be checked for personal/emergency reasons, please do that away from the scoretable during intervalsafter all scoretable duties are complete.
